Opera San José Single Tickets on Sale July 1

Four-opera subscription series still available

SAN JOSE, CA—Single tickets to performances during Opera San José’s 26th Anniversary Season will go on sale to the public on July 1. Subscription series of four operas are also available. Single-ticket prices range from \$51 to \$91, depending on seat location; a four-opera subscription series ranges from \$180 to \$320. Each of the season’s four operas has eight performances; all are at 8pm, except for Sunday matinees at 3.

“This is the time to get the best possible single seats for each opera,” said Michael Cheatwood, Opera San José box office manager. “We will continue to welcome season subscribers through September 27, so right now the selection of single seats is as good as it gets.”

The 2009–10 season opens September 12 with Massenet’s lush French romance, *Manon*. Rossini’s charming *Cinderella (La Cenerentola)* opens on November 14, followed by Mozart’s rollicking *The Marriage of Figaro* on February 6 and Puccini’s hauntingly beautiful *La rondine* on April 24. Special ticket prices for seniors (65+) and students (25 and under) are available only on performance days 90 minutes prior to curtain at the California Theatre’s box office, 345 South First Street in San José.
