Portraying a 15-year-old bride and her transformation into a worn straw widow set on her devotion — only to be brutally betrayed and ultimately pushed to her demise — is not an easy task. Adding to it the authenticity of costume and movement, meticulously reproduced onstage, makes the performer's job even more demanding. Ms. Forni as Madama Butterfly is at the top of game, shaping a highly believable character and never losing the strength of her beautiful vocal delivery.



Opera SJ resident mezzo-soprano Nicole Birkland is equally skillful and deeply touching in her role of Butterfly's maid Suzuki.
